

## **Exhibitor information sheet**

for the 26th Mainzer Minipressen-Messe (MMPM) in the Rheingoldhalle Mainz from 18. - 21.5. 2023



### **Arrival/Delivery**

The fair will take place in the Rheingoldhalle and therefore the destination of your journey is Rheinstraße 66, 55116 Mainz. You can deliver via the street "Am Rathaus", continue along the banks of the Rhine until you reach the back of the Rheingoldhalle. The approach is signposted. After unloading and setting up the stand, please park your vehicle in one of the adjacent parking garages.

So if you arrive by car, please take your mail "confirmation of participation" - it is the short-term parking permit for the exhibitors of the Minipresse - and attach it well visible behind the windshield. It entitles you to drive on the Rhine bank promenade for a stay of 60 minutes for loading and unloading next to the Rheingoldhalle. If the time is exceeded, the vehicles will be towed away. Please adhere to this regulation - especially in the interest of your colleagues.

### **Parking / Arrival by train / bus / cab**

Mainz is an environmental zone. Parking is available in various parking garages in the immediate vicinity of the trade fair. Either directly in the underground parking lot of the town hall (directly next to the Rheingoldhalle), or in the multi-storey parking lot "Löhrstraße" (diagonally opposite the town hall) or in the multi-storey parking lot "Rheinufer" (opposite the Electoral Palace). From there it is about a five-minute walk to the trade fair. Bus lines: 6, 6A, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 60, 61 go from the train station to the MMPM (Rheingoldhalle/Rathaus stop). For arrivals by cab, give the driver the address Rheingoldhalle, Rheinstr. 66. Mainz is an environmental zone. A green environmental sticker is expected.

### **Hotel accommodation**

The easiest way to book hotel accommodation is to make a reservation via the room contingent that the Mainz tourist office mainzplus has reserved for exhibitors at the Minipresse. If you want to look for a room yourself, the zip code area under which you can find a hotel near the Rheingoldhalle is 55116. A good tip for the cheapest accommodation is the very nicely located Mainzer Jugendherberge. Also from there it is not far to the fair:

### **Set-up**

The stand construction can take place from Thursday morning (May 18), from 8.00 am and must be completed by 1.00 pm. The tables are 2.00 m long and 0.60 m deep and will be provided with chairs free of charge, as well as the partition walls (depending on your registration). Attention: under no circumstances may tacks or nails be hammered into the partition walls (liability to recourse in case of any kind of damage!). Hanging can be done from above by means of a hook. The partition walls are 0.8 cm thick. Please bring cords, tape, tools and decoration material.
